The entry questions are designed to enable Entrants to succinctly present their idea, how it relates to the respective edition of the Competitions' challenge statement and the Judging Criteria.

  - Please ensure you provide a clear definition of the problem your idea solves and of the target population
- Why should your idea be considered viable
  - (i.e. likely to be financially sustainable over time)?
- How will your idea achieve impact related to the Competition's Challenge Statement?
- How will your idea scale across Europe?
- Explain how you will design and test the Idea with users and beneficiaries to support relevance and potential social impact
