## INTRODUCTION

The project concept call phase of the G-STIC Climate Action Programme - International Climate Finance Project Call 2022 - will take place from 18 May to 2 June 2022. Project applicants can submit their concept proposal on a template by 13:00 CEST on 2 June 2022. The submitted concepts will be screened and the applicants will be given feedback. This can then be taken into account in the further development of the project.

This step is not mandatory and the feedback is not a prelude to the selection of the full proposal but fits in with the more intensive guidance that will be provided to potential applicants.

The International Climate Finance Project Call 2022 focuses on projects by Flemish organisations that implement and upscale climate plans and solutions in developing countries. It is fully in line with the objectives of international climate financing as the main objective of the intended projects focuses on supporting developing countries in taking climate action and in reaching their climate targets, as described in Article 2 of the Paris Agreement.

The intended projects will help to disseminate the know-how and expertise of Flemish organisations. They must directly and explicitly lead to the strengthening of the climate policies, strategies, regulations, action plans and/or climate actions of developing countries, in terms of mitigation and/or adaptation.
